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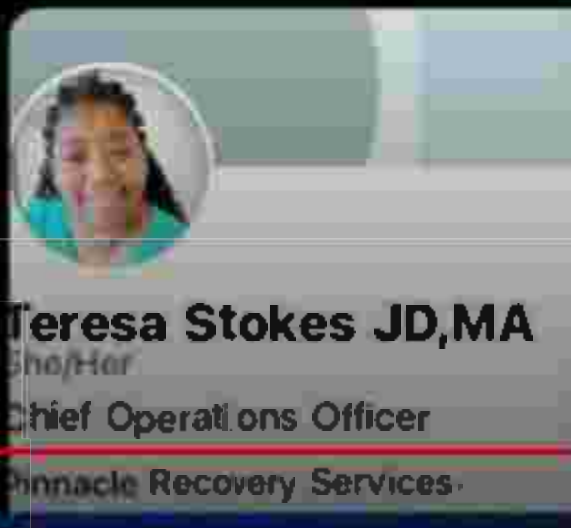

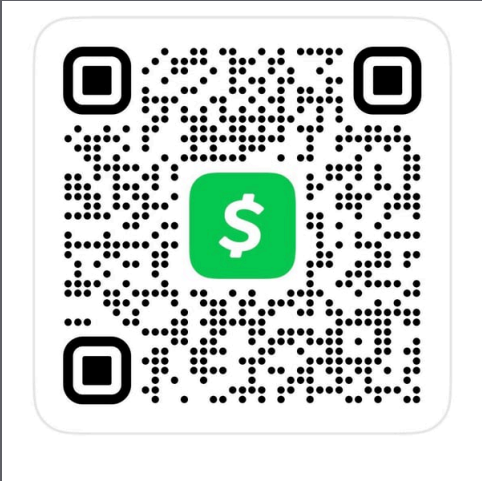

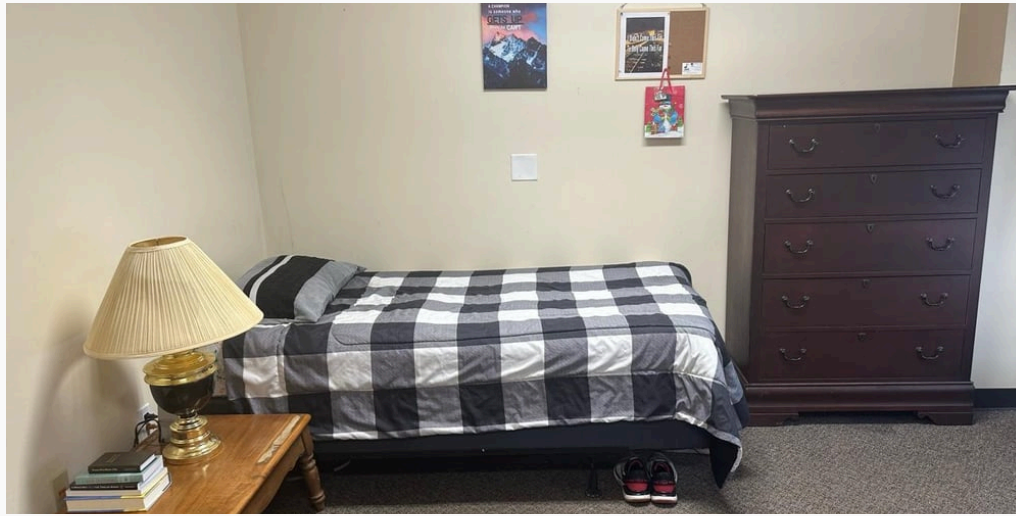

About Our Facility:

Our facility houses up to 26 males at our Old Lansing Road location, and residents are allowed to remain in the program for 90 days. Peer recovery coaches assist with developing personalized recovery plans and goals for long term recovery. Recovery may look different for each person, so we strive to help individuals find what works for them.

- Private and semi-private rooms (Single or up to 3 men per room)
- Commercial kitchen and shared space for food and beverages
- In house laundry facility -All bedding, furnishings, and appliances are provided in the facility
- Access to house phone and WiFi (Residents are allowed to bring their own cell phone as well)
- Accessibility to the CATA bus line, or you can have your personal vehicle after 30 days of residency
- Random drug and alcohol testing
- Smoking in designated areas

Pinnacle also offers a step-down housing program for individuals who have demonstrated a working recovery program and are willing to self-pay.

What We Offer:

Pinnacle offers a wide range of services to help individuals not only maintain recovery, but also address their physical, work, spiritual, and mental health. Some of our services include:

- Peer recovery coaches
- DHS help (food benefits, cash assistance)
